

# Year 3 News

## English

During this term, we will be carrying out lots of fun reading and writing activities. Our first English topic focuses on writing a diary entry which is linked to The Scarecrow's Wedding. We will also be working hard to develop he children's handwriting and spelling too.

Next half term, we will be looking at the book George's Marvellous Medicine by Roald Dahl. We will be using this text to develop the children's understanding of speech and being able to include this in their own witness statements. #### Maths

This term in maths, we will be focusing on:

- Place value
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division

## Geography

This half term, we will be starting an exciting new topic called 'The UK'. both physical and human features of Nottinghamshire.



## History
